Appearance: Dark brown pellets
Solubility in water: Partially Soluble
Ingredients: Sulphate of Potash, Ammonium Sulphate, Trace Elements, Poultry Manure

HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

Swallowed: Large doses can cause gastro-intestinal irritation & purging.
Eye: May cause local irritation.
Skin: Prolonged contact can cause skin dryness & irritation.
Inhaled: Dust may cause irritation to nose & throat.

FIRST AID

Swallowed: Give a glass of water.
Eye: If in eyes, hold eye open and flood with water for 10-15 minutes.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

Exposure Standards: No data available.
Engineering Controls: Avoid dust formation.
Personal Protection: Wear gloves when handling. Avoid breathing dust.
Flammability: The product is not flammable.

SAFE HANDLING INFORMATION

Storage and Handling: Store in a cool, dry area. Keep containers tightly closed when not in Use. Store away from oxidising agents.
Spills and Disposal: Avoid rising dust. Shovel into plastic container.
Flush excess with water into sewer.

Fire/Explosion Hazard: When burning, products may give rise to noxious fumes. If smoke or fumes are given off, wear self contained breathing apparatus. Do not spray water on to material if burning. Spread material to dissipate heat and smother the fire to extinguish.

OTHER INFORMATION:

This material contains a waste product from poultry sheds and abattoirs. It has undergone biological stabilisation and treatment to further reduce pathogens including onsite storage and composting. Care however in its handling and Avoiding unnecessary contact is recommended.
